Requirements

Candidates are required to have been employed full-time for three years as a chief staff executive OR five years as an executive association manager. Candidates must also have completed 100 hours of broad-based, association management-related continuing education or professional development within the last five years. This education must be directly related to nonprofit management. It should not be industry-specific, or required for candidate's particular position within their organization. Consultants are now eligible.
